	Acceptable	Unacceptable
Shirts	Long or Short sleeve polo style shirts or Oxford style collared shirts	No T-shirts as outerwear (except CFS t-shirts worn on the last school day of the week)
	Must have collars and button (the top button only may be left unbuttoned)	T-shirts may be worn under acceptable shirts
	Boys shirts must be tucked in	No logos on shirts other than small brand names
	CFS T-shirts or other CFS apparel may be worn on the last day of the week (can be purchased from PTF and various clubs throughout the year)	
Pants/Capris	Docker style pants, cargo pants, or capris; flat or pleated (Black, Navy, Brown, Grey, or Tan)	Jeans or any Denim Pants except as otherwise noted
	Pants/Capris must be worn at natural waistline	Over-sized or baggy pants
	Jeans or denim capris allowable on last day of week (must be in good condition, no holes)	Pants worn with chains
Shorts/Skort	Walking shorts, skorts, flat or pleated (Black, Navy, Brown, Grey, or Tan)	No jean/denim shorts/skort (except on the last school day of the week)
	Hem must be no shorter than one inch off the ground when kneeling	
Skirts/Jumpers	Skirts/Jumpers (Black, Navy, Brown, Grey, or Tan)	No jean/denim skirts/jumpers
	Hem must be no shorter than one inch off the ground when kneeling	
Sweaters/Sweatshirts	Crew, V-neck, cardigan or vests	
	Cardigan sweaters are: sweaters that are knitted material, open the full length of the center; may be fastened by buttons, zipper or tie/belt	
	Cardigan with hoods are allowed, however students may not wear the hoods on their heads while in the school building or while school is in session.	
	Turtleneck sweaters without a collared shirt	
	CFS sweatshirts or CFS hoodies any day	
	All sweaters, sweatshirts are to be worn with a collared shirt	
Turtleneck Shirts	May be worn under a sweater or sweatshirt	Worn as outerwear
Sport Coats/Blazers	May be worn with an approved shirt	No denim jackets or short jackets
	No head apparel may be worn inside school facilities	
Caps/Hats-Hair	Specific for boys: Hair should be above the eyebrows, not below the middle of the ear, not more than 1 inch in the back.	
Outerwear	Jackets and coats may be worn to your discretion, but are not allowed to be worn in the classroom.	
P.E. Dress Code	P.E. Shirts-may be CFS, solid or striped t-shirt	Skorts, denim, and sleeveless shirts are not permitted
	P.E. Shorts-hem should be no shorter than 1" off floor when kneeling Athletic style or normal dress code pants Sneakers	No pictures, words or advertisements are permitted on any clothing except for CFS attire P.E. Shoes other than sneakers
