Shirts	Acceptable	Unacceptable
	Long or Short sleeve polo style shirts or Oxford style collared shirts	No T-shirts as outerwear (except CFS t-shirts on the last school day of the week)
	Must have collars and button (the top button only may be left unbuttoned)	T-shirts may be worn under acceptable shirts
	Boys shirts must be tucked in	Shirts that cling to body
	Girls shirts must be long enough that no midriff is showing at any time	No logos on shirts other than small brand names
	CFS T-shirts or other CFS apparel may be worn on the last school day of the week (can be purchased from PTF and various other clubs throughout the school year)	
Pants/Capris	Docker style pants or capris, flat or pleated front in the colors of black, navy, brown, grey, or tan	Jeans or any denim pants except as otherwise noted
	Pants/capris must be worn at the natural waistline	Pants that are not a solid color
	Belts must be worn (boys only)	Tight-fitting pants
	Jeans or denim capris are allowable on the last school day of the week (must be in good condition, no holes)	Over-sized or baggy pants Pants worn with chains
	Walking shorts, skorts, flat or pleated front in the colors of black, navy, brown, grey, or tan	Tight-fitting shorts, skorts, or capris
	Belts must be worn (boys only)	No jean/denim shorts (except on the last school day of the week)
	Hem must be no shorter than one inch off the ground when kneeling	
Skirts/Jumpers	Skirts/Jumpers in the colors of black, navy, brown, grey, or tan	Tight-fitting skirts or jumpers
	Hem must be no shorter than one inch off the ground when kneeling	No jean/denim skirts or jumpers
Sweaters/Sweatshirts	Crew, V-neck, cardigan or vests	
	Cardigan sweaters are sweaters that are of knitted material, open the full length of the center front and may be fastened by buttons, zipper, or tie/belt	
	Cardigans with hoods are allowed, however students may not wear the hoods on their heads while in the school building or while school is in session	
	Turtleneck sweaters without a collared shirt	
	CFS sweatshirts or CFS hoodies any day	
	All sweaters, sweatshirts are to be worn with a collared shirt except as otherwise noted	
Turtleneck Shirts	May be worn under a sweater or sweatshirt	Worn as outerwear
Sport Coat/Blazers	May be worn with an approved shirt	No denim jackets or short jackets
Caps/Hats-Hair	No head apparel may be worn inside school facilities. Specific for boys: Hair should be above the eyebrows, not below the middle of the ear, not more than 1 inch in the back.	
Outerwear	Jackets and coats may be worn to your discretion, but are not allowed to be worn in the classroom.
