Post from KY Homeland Security -THREATEN A SCHOOL, BECOME A FELON

There have been 22 reported threats made against Kentucky schools since the tragic mass school shooting in Florida on February 14. Many of these threats were made using social media or by telephone.

Regardless of how the threat is carried out, it is important to understand that making a threat to a school is considered terroristic threatening—a felony offense.

To date, 14 of these 22 threats have resulted in arrests. Please review this information and share with your peers and family members, particularly individuals that are attending school.

- A threat to attack a school is a felony
- It does not matter if actions are carried out
- It does not matter what the intent was for the individual(s) making the threat
- Carrying a charge of terroristic threatening has long-lasting effects on an individual, even a person under the age of 18
- Saying the threat was a joke, false alarm, hoax, etc. is not a defense—what matters is whether or not the threat was believed and created fear

"A best practice for preventing a school shooting from happening in the future is recognizing indicators and immediately reporting signs of a potential active aggressor or shooter," warned Kentucky Office of Homeland Security John Holiday. "If you see something that makes you feel uncomfortable, such as someone with a spoken desire to join terrorist organizations – or social media involvement, talk of carrying out an attack spoken or social media, position or obsession with weapons, history of violence,

etc., make sure you say something. You could prevent a violent incident. Report all suspicious activity to KOHS by calling 866-EYE-ON-KY (393-6659).”
