Thank you for your interest in CFS preschool! I want to give you some additional information on the CFS preschool program. Preschool is definitely a learning experience. Not only do preschoolers become comfortable with a classroom setting, but they will learn academics and life skills. Preschoolers will learn the basics—phonics, reading, numbers, writing, etc.—plus many additional things such as Bible, music, art, library, history, science, and geography. I am especially excited about our geography studies. We have a class teddy bear that sends us letters and pictures of his adventures with a travel writer. We will also have special projects and units of study on the ocean, farms, zoo, and many others. I have included a formal curriculum guide that details our preschool studies.

You may choose to send your student half-day (dismissed at 11:15) or all-day (dismissed at 3:25). You may also choose 3 or 4 days per week. I believe this flexibility will better serve the needs of different family situations. I have included a tentative schedule of our day. This is a flexible schedule that will change to meet the students' needs. For example, the rest time may be shortened as the year progresses and the preschoolers get used to the school day.
