

CFS Middle School and High School Dress Code

Tops Only items on this list are permitted.	Long or short sleeve polo style shirts.
	Polos can have small brand logos but no wording or graphics are allowed.
	Official CFS apparel including CFS t-shirts, CFS sweatshirts, CFS hoodies, CFS half zip pull-overs.
	Shirts must be long enough that no midriff is showing at any time.
	Shirts do not have to be tucked in unless they are excessively long.
Bottoms Only items on this list are permitted	Pants, shorts, skorts, capris, skirts in an appropriate cut may be worn. Acceptable colors include shades of solid black, navy, brown, gray, or tan.
	Blue jeans and denim including pants, shorts, skorts, capris and skirts may be worn on the last day of the school week only. Must be in good condition with no holes, frays, or frayed hems.
	All hems must be at an appropriate length.
	No athletic or sweatpants allowed except official CFS team apparel on game day.
Outerwear	Outerwear, such as jackets and coats are to be removed when entering the building. Outerwear must be stored in the student's locker.
Caps/Hats/Hair	No head apparel may be worn inside school facilities.
	Bizarre styles and unnatural hair colors are not allowed
	Specific for boys: Hair should be styled so that it remains <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Above the eyebrows ● Above the earlobes ● At or above the collar length in the back
Team Apparel	Official CFS team warm ups can be worn on game day
	The final decision on all questions relating to dress code shall be made by the administration.
