

CFS Elementary Dress Code

Shirts	Long or Short sleeve polo style shirts or Oxford style shirts. Small brand logos are allowed. Other wording or graphics are not allowed.
	Shirts must have a collar and must be buttoned appropriately.
	Specific for boys: Shirts do not have to be tucked in unless they are excessively long.
	Shirts must be long enough that no midriff is showing AT ANY TIME.
	CFS T-shirts or other CFS apparel may be worn any day of the week (these may be purchased from PTF or many other CFS groups throughout the year).
Pants/Capris Shorts/Skorts	Pants, shorts, or capris in an appropriate cut may be worn. Acceptable solid colors include shades of Black, Navy, Brown, Grey, or Tan.
	Dark-colored Jeans, denim capris, and denim shorts are allowed every day (must be in good condition, no holes, no frayed hems)
	All hems must be at an appropriate length.
Skirts/Jumpers/Leggings	Solid colored Skirts/Jumpers may be worn in the shades of Black, Navy, Brown, Grey, or Tan. Dark-colored denim skirts/jumpers are acceptable any day of the week.
	Solid colored leggings/jeggings may be worn under an appropriate length skirt
	Hem must be at an appropriate length
	Sweaters, ¼ zip fleece pull-overs, and zippered pull-overs may be worn. Buttons and zippers are allowed on sweaters. Hoods are allowed, however students may not wear the hoods on their heads while in the school building. Small brand logos are allowed. Other wording or graphics are not allowed.
Sweaters/Sweatshirts/Turtle-necks Turtleneck Shirts	V-neck sweaters must be worn with a collared shirt underneath. Crew neck sweaters do not have to be worn with a collared shirt.
	CFS sweatshirts or CFS hoodies are allowed any day, but hoods are not allowed to be worn on the head in the school building.
	No head apparel may be worn inside school facilities Bizarre styles and unnatural hair colors are not allowed
Caps/Hats-Hair	Specific for boys: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair should be styled so that it remains above the eyebrows, above the earlobe, and at or above the collar length in the back.
Outerwear	Jackets and coats may be worn to your discretion, but are not allowed to be worn in the classroom.
Sport Coats/Blazers	Sport coats and blazers are acceptable any time. Appropriate denim jackets may be worn
P.E. Dress Code	P.E. Shirts-may be CFS t-shirts or regular dress code shirts. P.E. Shorts-hem should be an appropriate length Athletic style or normal dress code pants Sneakers

The final decision on all questions relating to dress code shall be made by the administration.
